

A REPORT ON THE REDESIGNING OF THE AUDA-NEPAD NIGERIA WEBSITE

INTRODUCTION:

This project entails redesigning the AUDA-NEPAD Nigerian website found on the domain: <https://auda-nepad.gov.ng> to conform to that of the International organization.

From our preliminary research, we discovered that the AUDA-NEPAD Nigerian website has the following defects:

- Take a long time to load (An average time of about 3 Minutes).
- The current website on AUDA-NEPAD does not properly represent the organization in its full glory. In the world of ICT, your website is considered your Digital/Online office. We have received a number of information to be used on the site from your team and we currently working on using them to redesign the website. At the end of the implementation of

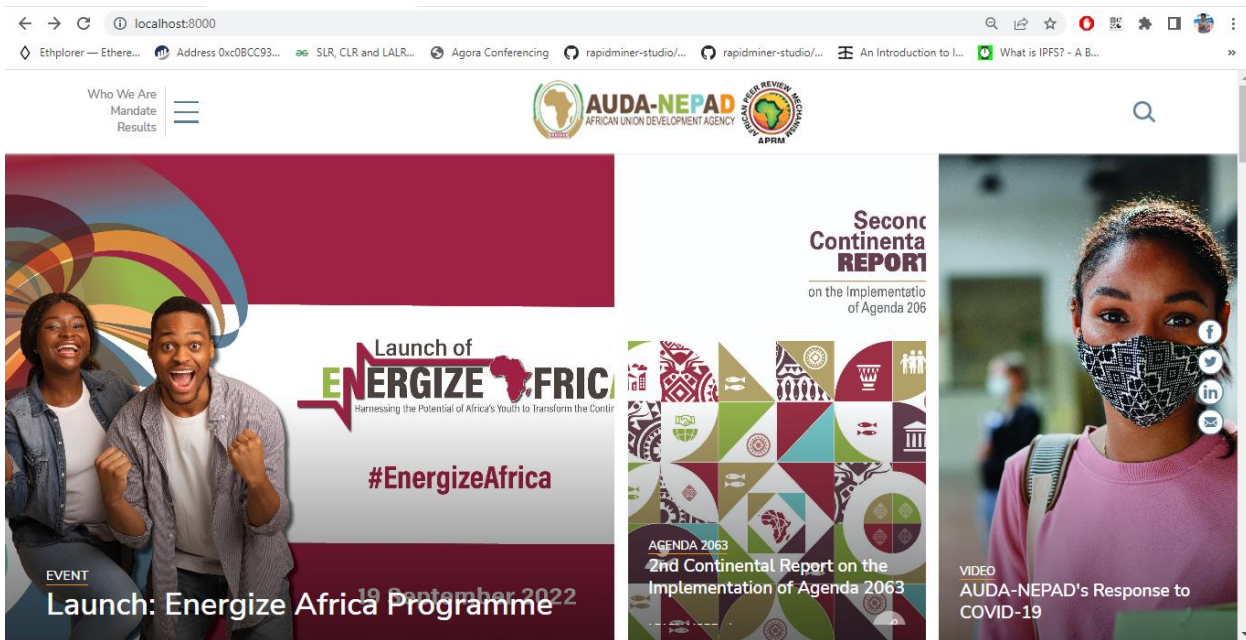
the information so far received, we will make a demonstration to your team for input and comments.

NEPAD strategic framework document was prepared by the leaders of the five initiating states (Nigeria, Algeria, Egypt, Senegal and South Africa). African heads of state and government met in Abuja, Nigeria, in October 2001 and adopted the name NEPAD. However following the transformation and domestication of the decision of the AU Heads of State and Government at the 31st Ordinary Session in Nouakchot, Mauritania, 1st – 2nd July 2018 the Agency is now known as African Union Development Agency (AUDA-NEPAD).

Since the creation of NEPAD and its transformation to AUDA-NEPAD, Nigeria has domesticated all her activities in line with its Coordinating Secretariat Guideline. The Agency have successful established its National Structures. It is also identifying critical and strategic stakeholders and partners, developing effective policy framework; implementing strategies; identified developmental needs as well as development of programmes and project that addressing these challenges and enriching humanity in line with global trend.
